





Women in Math at Waterloo

- 1993 Founded the Women in Math Committee
 - Advisory committee to the Dean
 - Encourage women faculty, staff, students in Math, through role models, mentoring programs, and community building
- 2007 Founded the Women in CS Committee
 - Ensure young women entering university see CS as an option
 - Address obstacles that CS women face in their work and studies
 - Connect with other organizations and events for women in CS
- 2015 Established the Director of Women in CS
